Candidates will be evaluated based on their proposed program of study, career objectives, presentation, and recommendation from their university professor. The OSITE selection committee reserves the right to consider regional universities located within the OSITE coverage areas when considering similar deserving applicant as a final award criterion. Applicants who do not meet the eligibility requirements and/or fail to comply with the application process will not be considered.

Amount

OSITE is making available three (3) \$500 scholarships available during the Spring 2022 semester.
